Object-Finding Scavenger Hunt

When setting up a home scavenger hunt, each clue should be placed at the previous location rather than the one it describes. This ensures players must find one clue to lead them to the next, rather than just stumbling upon answers too soon.

For example:

Clue 1 (given to the players): *"People knock on me to say hello but lock me up after the visitors go. What am I?"*

- This clue hints at the front door but should be placed at the starting point (e.g., handed to the players).

Clue 2 (hidden at the front door): *"After working all day, use me to wash the dirt away."*

- This clue hints at the bath/shower but should be placed at the front door.

Clue 3 (hidden in the bath/shower): *"I am soft in every bit. On me, you're often pleased to sit. What am I?"*

- This clue hints at the sofa but should be placed in the bath/shower.

Clue 4 (hidden on the sofa): *"Drop me and the world will shatter. You will find me where you empty your bladder."*

- This clue hints at the bathroom mirror but should be placed on the sofa.

Clue 5 (hidden at the bathroom mirror): *"I have a head and tail but no legs. I am that for which the beggar begs. What am I?"*

- This clue hints at a coin/loose change but should be placed at the bathroom mirror.

Clue 6 (hidden with the loose change): *"Warm bytes my body craves. Make it quick with tiny waves. What am I?"*

- This clue hints at the microwave but should be placed with the loose change.

Clue 7 (hidden in the microwave): *"All shining and silver with a beautiful face. Look into me and find the next clue's hiding place."*

- This clue hints at a mirror but should be placed in the microwave.

Clue 8 (hidden at the mirror): *"I demand an answer but ask no question. What am I?"*

- This clue hints at a phone but should be placed at the mirror.

Clue 9 (hidden with the phone): *"What has keys with no locks, space but no room, and allows you to enter but you can't go in?"*

- This clue hints at a keyboard but should be placed with the phone.

Clue 10 (hidden in the keyboard): *"I am a small room but no one lives inside. No matter what the weather, it is very cold where my residents reside. What am I?"*

- This clue hints at the freezer but should be placed in the keyboard.

Clue 11 (hidden in the freezer): *"A mirror for the famous. Informative to all—I'll show you the world but it may be a bit small. What am I?"*

- This clue hints at the TV but should be placed in the freezer.
